

Suggestions for Use

A flashcard is provided for each of the 56 signers of the Declaration of Independence. As you study each man, use the flashcard to become familiar with his face and the character quality he represents. You can even post the flashcard on the refrigerator if you wish or frame it while you are studying the life of this man. On the back side of each card is a Scripture verse to learn to help you internalize God's truth about this character trait. Use the flashcards to drill the information and review previously learned signers as well to help

retain what you have learned and make it a

part of your life.


PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS


The flashcards should be printed double-sided. Printing on cardstock will make them more durable. You can also have them laminated if you wish. Most printers have an option for printing a double-sided document.


If you have any trouble doing so, here is a link to a great site that explains in detail how to print double-sided, with either a PC or a MAC:



Cutting each sheet in the center horizontally and vertically should give you four cards measuring 4.25×5.5 inches, with a 1/4 inch margin all around.
