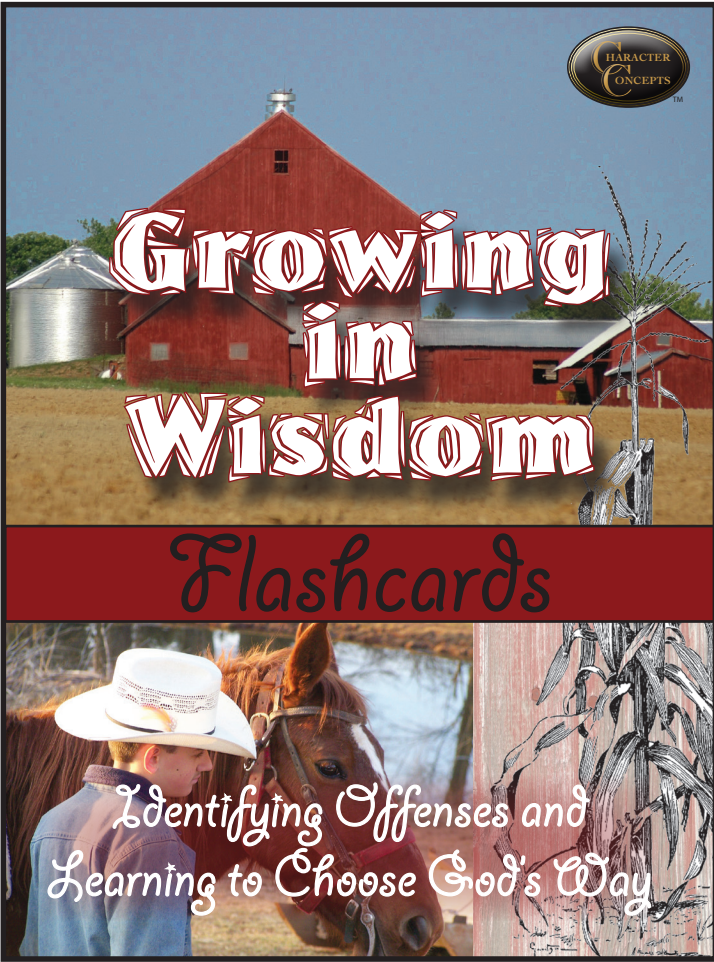

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

The flashcards should be printed double-sided. Printing on cardstock will make them more durable. You can also have them laminated if you wish. Most printers have an option for printing a double-sided document.

If you have any trouble doing so, here is a link to a great site that explains in detail how to print double-sided, with either a PC or a MAC:

Cutting each sheet in the center horizontally and vertically should give you four cards measuring 4.25 x 5.5 inches, with a 1/4 inch margin all around.
