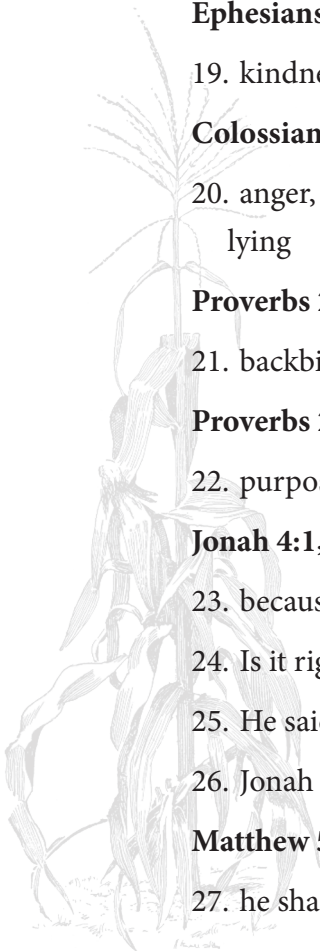

Exodus 32:19

Moses was angry when he came down from the mountain and saw that the people had made a golden calf to worship and turned away from God. In his anger he threw down the tablets containing God's laws and they broke into pieces.

Numbers 22:27

Balaam was angry at his donkey because it veered off the path and crushed his foot against the wall. He didn't know it was protecting him. His anger caused him to mistreat his faithful donkey.

Numbers 24:10

Balak was angry with Balaam. He told Balaam to flee to his home. He had planned to honor him, but instead the Lord had kept Balaam from receiving this honor.

Judges 14:19

Sampson's wife betrayed him and he was angry and killed 30 men. Because he got angry and went to his father's home, his father-in-law thought he didn't wish to be married anymore and gave his wife to another man.

Esther 1:12

King Ahasuerus was angry when his wife Vashti wouldn't appear before him and perform. His anger caused him to banish his wife from his presence and no longer fulfill his duties as a husband.
